- 1. A copy of the IRS determination letter, indicating 501(c) nonprofit status;
- 2. A copy of your organization's Articles of Incorporation, Constitution, and/or By-Laws, documenting your organization's purpose;
- 3. Any publications or other documentation issued by your organization which would provide details regarding the organization's retreat and any services provided at that location.

<u>Note:</u> All information contained on this application is subject to <u>VERIFICATION</u> by Maine Revenue Services. Maine Revenue Services may request additional information or documentation necessary to determine eligibility.
