



**STATE OF MAINE
TAX DECLARATION FOR CIGARETTES**

Under Maine law, consumers are required to pay Maine taxes on cigarettes possessed in Maine. When you buy from a retailer in Maine, the taxes have been paid (see the Maine tax stamps on the bottom of each pack). When you purchase in any month more than two cartons of cigarettes that do not bear a Maine cigarette tax stamp, the cigarette and use taxes must be declared and paid on all of the cigarettes possessed. **TAX IS DUE ON ALL CIGARETTES IMPORTED INTO THIS STATE.**
