CERTIFIED MAINE ASSESSOR EXAM

The next Certified Maine Assessor exam will be held on **Tuesday, March 3rd in Augusta.**

The exam will begin at 8:00am and end at 4:30pm, with a 1/2-hour lunch break. The exam will be held in Room 101 of the Deering Building (90 Blossom Lane, Augusta).

No time adjustment will be made for late arrivals.

The exam consists of five parts. A minimum score of 70 on each part is required to pass. If you don't pass all parts of the exam, you will only have to retake the parts on which you scored less than 70. For more information, see MRS Rule 205 on the Property Tax Division website:

Part I of the exam will be passed out at 8:00am and must be completed within four hours. Part I covers Maine property tax law with 50 two-part short-answer questions. Reference materials are provided for this open-book part.

Parts II-V will be given to the candidate once Part I is completed and the reference materials are turned in. Parts II-V each contain 50 multiple choice questions of a general, information/problem solving nature. These parts do not have a specific time limit, but all parts, including Part I, must be completed by 4:30pm.

Only pencils and calculators will be permitted in the testing room. The calculator feature on a cell phone is not allowed. All other material necessary for the exam will be provided.

Registrations must be submitted with a \$25, non-refundable exam fee by Friday, February 20th.
