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MRS Rulemaking Activity Proposed Rule

New Rule 816, "Dirigo Business Incentives Tax Credit." MRS is proposing new Rule 816 to implement the Maine income tax credit recently enacted by P.L. 2023, c. 412, Pt. J, § 13. The credit, found in the law at 36 M.R.S. § 5219-AAA, applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2025. The refundable credit (subject to limitations) is based on a combination of expenditures to purchase eligible business property and to train qualified employees for a qualified business activity carried on primarily in an eligible sector. MRS is jointly proposing this rule with the Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD), which is proposing this same rule under DECD Chapter 301.
