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# NOW Available – Maine Tax Portal Improves Access, Functionality for Taxpayers and Tax Professionals

The Maine Tax Portal is now live -- providing improved functionality and online access – and enabling taxpayers and tax professionals to file returns and remit payments online, view bills and notices, and perform account maintenance activities, such as adding or removing addresses and closing an account.

Begin using the Maine Tax Portal NOW for any of the following tax types:

- Corporate Income Tax
- Franchise Tax
- Insurance Premiums Taxes (including Fire and Non-Admitted Premiums)
- Estate Tax
- Health Care Provider Tax
- Blueberry, Potato, Mahogany Quahog, and Railroad Excise Taxes
- Marijuana Excise Tax

#### Additional Tax Types Will Be Available Through the Maine Tax Portal Soon

The Maine Tax Portal replaces a decades-old system and will integrate *all* taxes administered by MRS into a new, single online system. This will be accomplished in four phases over four years. Preparations are underway for phase two, which will launch this October and will incorporate the following additional taxes and programs:

- Withholding
- Pass-Through Entity Withholding
- Use
- Sales
- Pre-Paid Wireless Fee
- Recycling Assistance Fee
- Pesticide Fee
- Service Provider
- Municipal Valuation Returns (MVR)

- Commercial Forestry Excise
- Telecommunications Excise
- Real Estate Transfer
- Controlling Interest Transfer
- Land Use Planning Commission Fee
- Business Equipment Tax Reimbursement (BETR)
