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2025 Maine Property Tax School

The Property Tax Division of MRS will be holding their annual Maine Property Tax School from June 2 through June 6, 2025. This year’s Property Tax School will be held at Thomas College in Waterville. If you plan to attend any of the classes, fill out the registration form at the end of the brochure, and send it to cma.mrs@maine.gov. The Maine Property Tax School is open to anyone with an interest in assessment, appraisal, and property taxation. The school provides continuing education for part-time and full-time Maine assessors as well as others involved in appraisal and assessment administration in the state.

The school traditionally offers three introductory courses and a review course for those who plan to sit for the Certified Maine Assessor (CMA) exam on Friday of that week. Several general education courses and a few advanced education courses are also offered.
