**Leadership**: The nominee in either formal or informal roles, demonstrates ability to influence others, empathy, and courage to confront challenges. As a leader, they work <u>with</u> their community, such as by involving community members in decision making, or keeping them informed, or ensuring that they have active part of their work.

**Commitment to Social Justice**: The nominee works for civil and human rights, such as the right to vote, fair access to resources and opportunities and freedom from discrimination and/prejudice.

**Improve Quality of Life:** The nominee helps people in their community or in specific groups by: increasing awareness of problems, identifying and/or promoting solutions, increasing access to food or other basic needs, education, healthcare, voting, transportation, and employment, and increasing social connections and feelings of belonging.
