- 1. Federally Required Questions: (Required)
 - A person who is not a U.S. Citizen is not eligible to vote or register to vote.
 - A person must be at least **18 years of age** to <u>vote</u> in a Municipal, General, or Referendum election. Note - A person who is at least **16 years of age** may <u>pre-register</u> to vote.
- 2. Party Affiliation: (Required) Voters may choose to:
 - Enroll in one of Maine's qualified political parties;
 - Enroll in a qualifying party (select "Other" and write in the name of the qualifying party). Note: The only current qualifying party is the Constitution Party; or
 - Not be affiliated with any Maine qualified political party ("Unenrolled").

Voters who wish to enroll in a party must check the box next to the party of their choice. Enrolled voters can participate in party caucuses, conventions, and other political party activities. Voters who wish to remain politically unaffiliated must check the box next to "Unenrolled (no party choice)". **Unenrolled voters can vote in <u>one party's primary election (of the voter's choice) and other elections</u> but are not eligible to participate in party caucuses or conventions.**

3. <u>Name of Voter</u>: (Required) A voter must provide the voter's legal name, as follows:

- Last name (surname) must be listed (Suffixes, such as Sr., Jr., II, etc, may be included); and
 - First name and the middle name or initial; or
 - First initial and full middle name; or
 - First name only
- 4. <u>Date of Birth:</u> (Required) Voters must be at least 18 years of age to vote. Under Maine law, 16-year-olds may pre-register to vote (and enroll in a party, if desired).
- 5. A. <u>Current Residence Address</u>: (Required) Voters must provide the current street address or physical location where they have established their residence. This <u>cannot</u> be a PO Box.

B. <u>Current Mailing Address</u>: (If applicable) The mailing address is required <u>only</u> if it is different from the residence address and is where the voter receives mail. This can be a PO Box.

C. <u>Previous Registration Address</u>: (Required) If a voter previously has been registered to vote, the voter must check the "YES" box and <u>must</u> provide municipality and/or county, and state of previous registration. If <u>never</u> registered, the voter must check the "NO" box.

6. <u>Telephone Number</u>: (Optional) If a voter provides a phone number, it becomes public information. A voter whose phone number is unpublished is cautioned against listing it on the application.

- 7. <u>Change of Name</u>: (If applicable) This information is required <u>only</u> if the voter's legal name has been changed since registering to vote in Maine.
- 8. <u>Voter's Signature</u>: (Required) Voters must sign their legal name below the statement certifying that all the provided information is true.
- <u>Voter ID or Unique ID Number</u>: (For new Maine voters only) The purpose of the voter ID number is to uniquely designate each new voter in the computerized statewide voter registration list. If the person is already registered to vote in Maine, this number is not required.
 - A. Driver's License Number: <u>New voters</u> who have a valid Maine Driver's License or a Maine State ID **must** list that number.
 - **B.** Social Security Number: <u>New voters</u> who do not have a valid Maine Driver's License or Maine State ID must list the last four digits of their Social Security Number.
 - **C. NONE:** This designation may be used <u>only</u> by voters who <u>do not have</u> a Maine Driver's License/State ID or a Social Security Number.

NOTE: Voter ID is confidential information (i.e., not public) and must be concealed during public inspection of voter registration cards.

- 10. <u>Instructions to Voters</u>: New voters who register by mail must provide a copy of certain identity documents with the completed registration form. The mail-in registrant may submit a copy of a Maine Driver's License or other valid photo ID, a current utility bill, a bank statement, a paycheck stub, or other government document that shows the voter's current name and address.
- 11. For Registrar's Use Only: This space must be completed only by the municipal registrar.

NOTE: If required information is omitted, the registrar must notify the applicant that the application is rejected because it is incomplete. If optional information is omitted, the registrar must still process and accept the application.
