# **New Business and MePCSW Governance**

- 1. Strategic Planning
  - a. Discussed initial feedback on draft strategic goals and overview of proposed updates.
    - i. Suggestion to make sure that language in goals is measurable (e.g., what do we mean by "strengthen")
  - Discussion about role of MePCSW consideration of partners and avoiding duplication, thinking about how to connect communities with the work of the Commission without overtaxing resources
  - c. Opportunities for future surveys consider including names with survey results to get a better sense of how to engage members and who is not engaged "people vote with their bodies"
