Communication Plan

Hold three listening sessions with municipalities

1. One session in mid-late January to introduce the project and listen to feedback
2. Second session in September of 2024 when we have more definitive answers to share
3. Third session in January 2025 for the final project plan



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In 2023 the State Legislature amended the law, requiring the BMV to design and issue a new plate beginning May 1, 2025 for all new registrations and renewals, to replace the current chickadee plates.

The last reissuance was in 1999, nearly 25 years ago. Many plates are old and in disrepair and have lost their reflectivity.




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- This will impact about 900,000 registrations
- Towns issue about 80% of all registrations

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New Plate Issue May 1, 2025 - July 2026



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Beginning May 1, 2025

- The BMV and Agents will not issue any more general issue Chickadee Plates
- For new registrations and renewals in the PC class code, registrants can choose:
 - a Pine Tree Plate (existing PC class code)
 - a “no tree plate” (new NT class code)
 - one of the current specialty plates (normal fees apply)
- Reserving current plate numbers will be an option through a centralized, web-based solution.




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Pine Tree Plate (Existing Class Code – PC)



No Tree Plate (New Class Code – NT)



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15 additional class codes will become Pine Tree Plates

(the NT plate is not available for these class codes)



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Tractors and Special Mobile Equipment



(Existing Class Code – TR)

Road Tractor:

- Designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles, but not constructed to carry any load.

Farm Tractors and Homemade Tractors:

- Used primarily as a farm implement for drawing plows and mowing machines.

Special Mobile Equipment: ***New class code of SM**

- Every self-propelled vehicle not designed or used primarily for transportation or property, but which are operated over the highway.



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What is different with reissuance?

May 1, 2024 (one year in advance)

- People will be able to reserve their current plate number. Goal is to have this capability available one year in advance. Central website, similar to vanity plate process.

May 1, 2025 – reissuance begins

- Almost everyone (except for specialty plates) will need to get a new set of plates at registration time.
- All renewal registrations (for Chickadee plates) will need to have plates issued.



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Limited New Authority

- New registration with old plate (NROP) –Maine Dealer Only up to 26,000 lbs.
- New registration transfer –Maine Dealer Only up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration transfer –up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration with weight changes up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration without weight changes up to 100,000 lbs.
- Name Addition/Deletion (MV-138)
- Duplicate registrations (MV-11)
- Duplicate stickers (MV-14)
- Special Registration Permits (MVR-10)
- Excise Tax Reimbursement for vehicles registered for over 26,000 lbs.
- Transit plates with or without Permit to move to an inspection station



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Limited New Authority

Issue the new plates for:

- New registration with old plate (NROP) –Maine Dealer Only up to 26,000 lbs.
- New registration transfer –Maine Dealer Only up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration transfer –up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration with weight changes up to 26,000 lbs.
- Re-registration without weight changes up to 100,000 lbs.



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What does all this mean for Limited New municipalities?

- We are asking you to carry plates (inventory) for the reissuance.
- You will have two new class codes
 - One for the general issue (NT)
 - One for Special Mobile Equipment (SM)
- If Limited New municipalities choose not to issue the general issue plates, we will require you to drop to excise only during the new plate issue.
