On February 15, 2019, the Maine Labor Relations Board received a duly executed Petition for Decertification/Bargaining Agent Election (MLRB Form 2A) filed pursuant to 26 M.R.S.A. § 967(2) by William Doyle, a representative of the National Correctional Employees Union (NCEU). Inasmuch as the requirements set forth in Chapter 11 of the Board Rules were met, a Decertification/Bargaining Agent Election by mail ballot was scheduled to be conducted among employees in the collective bargaining unit described below between Friday, March 15, 2019, and Tuesday, April 2, 2019. In accordance with Board Rule Chap. 11, § 14(2) and § 46, sample ballots and notices of the election were prepared and distributed on February 28, 2019, for both informational and posting purposes to Mr. Doyle for NCEU, to Lorne Smith for Teamsters Local Union No. 340 (Teamsters), and to Somerset County Administrator Dawn DiBlasi. On March 15, 2019, ballots were mailed to all members of the unit included in the list of eligible voters prepared by the employer.
