**RE: Notice of Suspension of Maine Physician License**

Dear Dr. Sundaram:

On July 8, 2019, the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("Board") reviewed information regarding your compliance with the terms and conditions of your Consent Agreement dated August 8, 2017 (complaint numbers CR15-116, CR15-137, CR15-178, and CR16-33), a copy of which is enclosed with this notice. Following review, the Board determined that you were in material noncompliance of the requirement that you comply with all aspects of the CPEP Education Plan.

As a result, pursuant to paragraph 21(a)(4) of the Consent Agreement, your license to practice medicine in the State of Maine is suspended, effective immediately. You are not authorized to practice medicine or delegate medical acts.
