
NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to M. Bar R. 13(e)(5), notice is now provided that the matter entitled *Board of Overseers of the Bar v. Christopher J. Whalley, Esq.*, Grievance Commission File No. 18-452, is scheduled for a disciplinary hearing before a panel of the Grievance Commission of the Board of Overseers of the Bar on **December 18, 2019 at 9:00 AM at the Penobscot Judicial Center located at 78 Exchange Street in Bangor, Maine, in Courtroom 202.**

The panel members will be Chair Jane S.E. Clayton, Esq.; Cynthia M. Mehnert, Esq.; and public member Milton R. Wright. If the Respondent has any objection to the composition of the panel, the Respondent shall submit a statement of the objection and grounds therefore in writing to the undersigned Clerk before December 2, 2019. Respondent shall have the right to be represented by an attorney, to cross-examine witnesses and to present evidence.

Admissibility of evidence will be determined by the panel at the hearing pursuant to M. Bar R. 13(e)(7)(C). Therefore, in order for the panel to properly review in advance all intended documentary exhibits (including those subject to objection), Bar Counsel and Respondent shall exchange and submit three hardcopies of all exhibits (jointly or separately) with their respective witness and exhibit lists (including any stipulations of fact) to the undersigned Clerk by December 4, 2019.
