

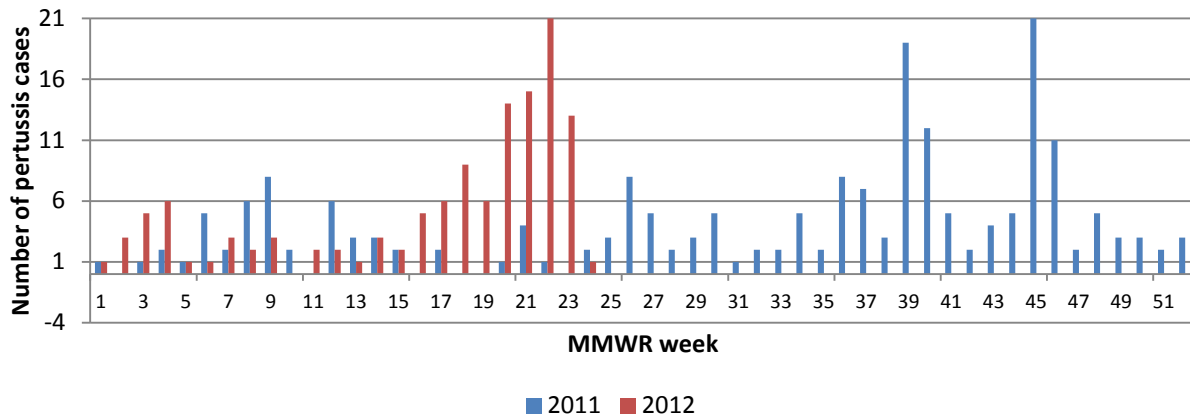
# Maine Weekly Pertussis Surveillance Report

06/14/2012

This update summarizes reports of pertussis infection in persons reported during 2012 received by the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (Maine CDC) during January 1 – June 14, 2012.

There have been a total of 125\* confirmed and probable pertussis cases reported statewide through June 14, 2012, compared to 50 reported cases in 2011 during the same period. \*Additional cases may have occurred especially in the most recent weeks that are not included in this report.
