ORDER

MAY 15 2003

After hearing before the Court on May 6, 2003 and by agreement of the parties concerning the Board of Overseers of the Bar's motion, it is HEREBY ORDERED:

1) On or before June 6, 2003 Ronald L. Bishop shall complete and file with the Court the accounting required by the Court's disbarment order of June 6, 2002;

2) Attorney Michael Seitzinger is relieved of the receiver status he was appointed to serve in this matter under that earlier order;


3) On or before May 19, 2003, the Board of Overseers of the Bar shall arrange to have all files of former clients of Mr. Bishop removed from his residence at 9 Abbott Street, Waterville and from Mr. Seitzinger's residence at 93 Ganneston Drive, Augusta, and relocated to either of the following two law office locations in Waterville: *Jabar, Batten, Ringer & Murphy*, or *Marden, Dubord, Bernier & Stevens*;

4) The Board of Overseers of the Bar is ordered to then provide reasonable public notice by newspaper announcement(s) or other appropriate methods, that former clients of Mr. Bishop may obtain their files from either of those two law offices and that any files not so claimed within 30 days of such notice shall be destroyed by the Board;

5) Without removal of any files, Mr. Bishop shall be allowed access to all such former clients' files at *Marden, Dubord, Bernier & Stevens* for his completion of that accounting and shall prepare daily inventory reports for a designee at that firm, with copies of those reports provided to Bar Counsel by that designee;

6) Mr. Bishop shall reimburse Mr. Seitzinger; *Jabar, Batten, Ringer & Murphy*; *Marden, Dubord, Bernier & Stevens*; and the Board of Overseers of the Bar for their respective expenses and attorney time devoted to this matter.
