Based upon the Motion as filed by the Board of Overseers of the Bar in the above matter, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1) The Board of Overseers of the Bar will provide reasonable-public notice by publication in *The Ellsworth American* of an announcement to inform former Maine attorney Lenore Anderson's former clients to obtain their properly identified files from Attorney Ellen Best either at Ms. Best's law office at 36 Main Street, Blue Hill, Maine (Telephone number: (207) 374-2573) or at Ms. Anderson's former law office location on Union Street also in Blue Hill, with that notice informing those clients that any such files not claimed within 30 days of the date of that public notice shall be destroyed forthwith by the Board of Overseers of the Bar;
- 2) Attorney Best is authorized to remove and dispose of any remaining debris from Ms. Anderson's former law office; and
- 3) Attorney Best is authorized to have Ms. Anderson's former clients' computer files removed from the computer system and to take whatever further steps she deems necessary and appropriate for either preservation on or destruction of those computers.
