Re: Surrender of License In Lieu of Proceeding to Adjudicatory Hearing – Complaint CR17-11

Dear Members of the Board:

I, Harry M. Peddie, M.D., hereby surrender my Maine medical license (MD5232) to the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine (“Board”) in lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing on April 11, 2017, regarding Complaint CR17-11. I understand that if the Board votes to accept the surrender of my Maine medical license in lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing, that such action is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank, the Federation of State Medical Boards, and that it will constitute a publicly available adverse action on the Board’s website. I understand that I have a right to an adjudicatory hearing before the Board regarding Complaint CR17-11, the right to be represented by a private attorney at my expense at such a hearing, and that by signing and dating this letter I am waiving those rights.
