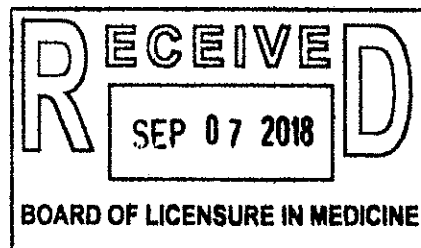
This document is an Interim Consent Agreement, effective when signed by all parties, regarding disciplinary action against the license to practice medicine in the State of Maine held by Daniel Bobker, M.D. The parties to the Interim Consent Agreement are: Daniel Bobker, M.D. ("Dr. Bobker"), the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("the Board"), and the State of Maine Department of the Attorney General. This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 M.R.S. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S. § 3282-A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Dr. Bobker has held a license to practice medicine in the State of Maine since February 15, 1995 (license number MD13940), and specializes in neurology.

2. On August 14, 2018, the Board issued an Order of Immediate Suspension of Dr. Bobker's license pursuant to 5 M.R.S. § 10004(3). The Board also required that Dr. Bobker obtain a neuropsychological, psychological, and substance use evaluation pursuant to 32 M.R.S. § 3286.

3. The Board at its meeting on August 14, 2018, authorized the entry of an interim consent agreement to continue the suspension of Dr. Bobker's license beyond that authorized pursuant to 5 M.R.S. § 10004(3) until the matter is finally resolved.



4. On August 15, 2018, the Board set this matter for an adjudicatory hearing to be held on September 11, 2018.

5. This Interim Consent Agreement has been negotiated by legal counsel for Dr. Bobker and legal counsel for the Board in order to postpone the adjudicatory hearing scheduled on September 11, 2018, until at least October 9, 2018. Absent acceptance of this Interim Consent Agreement by signing and dating it before a notary and returning it to the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine, 137 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0137 on or before September 7, 2018, the matter shall proceed to the scheduled adjudicatory hearing. Legal counsel for Dr. Bobker and legal counsel for the Board anticipate that a consent agreement fully resolving this matter will be presented to the Board at its October 9, 2018 meeting.

COVENANTS

6. Dr. Bobker agrees to the continued SUSPENSION of his license to practice as a physician in the State of Maine effective upon the execution of this Interim Consent Agreement, which suspension shall remain in effect until such time as the Board takes further action regarding this matter.

7. This Interim Consent Agreement is not appealable and is effective until modified or rescinded in writing by the parties hereto.

8. The Board and the Department of the Attorney General may communicate and cooperate regarding Dr. Bobker or any other matter relating to this Interim Consent Agreement.

9. This Interim Consent Agreement is a public record within the meaning of 1 M.R.S. § 402 and will be available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 M.R.S. § 408-A.

10. This Interim Consent Agreement constitutes discipline and is an adverse licensing action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB), the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB), and other licensing jurisdictions.

11. Nothing in this Interim Consent Agreement shall be construed to affect any right or interest of any person not a party hereto. If any clause of this Interim Consent Agreement is deemed illegal or invalid, then that clause shall be deemed severed from this Interim Consent Agreement.

12. Dr. Bobker acknowledges by his signature hereto that he has read this Interim Consent Agreement, that he has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Interim Consent Agreement, that he executed this Interim Consent Agreement of his own free will and that he agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.

13. Dr. Bobker has been represented by Kenneth W. Lehman, Esq., who has participated in the negotiation of the terms of this Interim Consent Agreement.


14. For the purposes of this Interim Consent Agreement, the term "execution" means the date on which the final signature is affixed to this Interim Consent Agreement.

I, DANIEL BOBKER, M.D., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT AND AGREE WITH ITS CONTENTS AND TERMS. I FURTHER UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING THIS INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO A HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD. I SIGN THIS INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND, VERBAL, WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE.

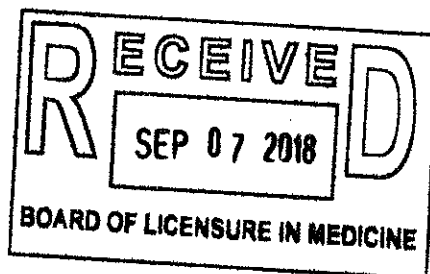


