

**Maine Board of Dental Practice  
Subcommittee on Dental Hygienists  
Meeting Minutes – June 14, 2019**

The meeting convened at 8:00 a.m.

**Minutes – May 17, 2019:** Following their review, Ms. Grenier made a motion to approve the minutes as drafted. Dr. Davis seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**Applications for Review:**

- Karina Coronel, RDH – Applications for Local Anesthesia and Nitrous Oxide Analgesia Authorities: After a review and discussion of the application materials presented, including the course and examination information, Ms. Grenier made a motion to recommend that the Board approve the course and examination as meeting the requirements, and grant Ms. Coronel a local anesthesia and nitrous oxide analgesia authority. Dr. Morse seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Stephanie Seger, RDH – Application for Local Anesthesia Authority: After a review and discussion of the application materials presented, including the course and examination information, Ms. Grenier made a motion to recommend that the Board approve the course and examination as meeting the requirements, and grant Ms. Seger a local anesthesia authority. Dr. Davis seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Dayna Woods – Applications for Dental Hygiene Licensure, Local Anesthesia and Nitrous Oxide Authorities: After a review and discussion of the application materials presented, including additional documents submitted as part of the licensee's disclosure of criminal conduct, Ms. Grenier made a motion to recommend that the Board conditionally approve licensure and authorities for Ms. Woods, pending receipt of a clear substance abuse assessment completed by the Maine Medical Professionals Health Program. Dr. Morse seconded the motion and it passed with Ms. Foster recused.

**Limited Delegation of Authority to Board Staff to Review and Approve Applications and Offer Consent Agreements:** A draft chart identifying the conditions under which limited delegation to board staff is authorized to review and process applications involving certain disclosures was reviewed... Following their discussion of the draft chart, Dr. Davis made a

motion to accept the chart as presented. Dr. Morse seconded the motion and it passed with Ms. Grenier opposed.
