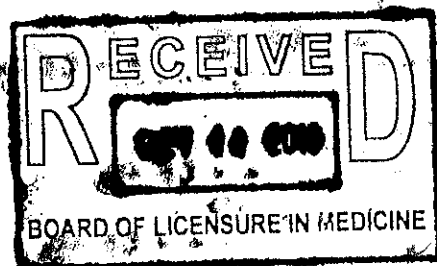

MILA THOMAS RIEHL, M.D.) CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR LICENSURE
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This document is a Consent Agreement, effective when signed by all parties, regarding the pending application for a medical license in the State of Maine of Mila Thomas Riehl, M.D. The parties to the Consent Agreement are: Mila Thomas Riehl, M.D. ("Dr. Riehl"), the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("the Board") and the State of Maine Department of the Attorney General. This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 M.R.S. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S. § 3282-A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. On September 14, 2018, Dr. Riehl submitted an application for a Maine medical license. On her application, Dr. Riehl disclosed that she has been in both active and voluntary monitoring with the Alabama Physician Health Program ("APHP") since 1992. Information received in connection with Dr. Riehl's application indicated that she signed a Lifetime Agreement with the APHP in June 2017, following a second relapse.

2. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. § 3271(5), an applicant may not be licensed unless the Board finds that the applicant is qualified and no cause exists, as set forth in section 3282-A, that may be considered grounds for disciplinary action against a licensed physician or surgeon.



3. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. § 3282-A(2)(B), the Board may refuse to issue, or impose other discipline for misuse of alcohol, drugs or other substances that has resulted or that may result in the licensee performing services in a manner that endangers the health or safety of patients.

4. On October 9, 2018, the Board reviewed the foregoing information and voted to preliminarily deny Dr. Riehl's application for a medical license. In lieu of the denial, the Board also voted to offer Dr. Riehl this Consent Agreement. Should Dr. Riehl decide to accept this Consent Agreement, she should sign it and date it in front of a notary and return it to the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine, 137 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0137 on or before November 5, 2018. Should Dr. Riehl decide not to accept this Consent Agreement and wish to appeal the preliminary denial of her application for licensure, Dr. Riehl must submit a written request for an adjudicatory hearing to the Board within thirty (30) days of receipt of the Notice of Preliminary Denial of License Application or the preliminary denial of her application will become final.

COVENANTS

5. Dr. Riehl admits the foregoing facts and that such conduct constitutes grounds for denial of licensure and imposition of other discipline pursuant to 32 M.R.S. § 3282-A(2)(B).

6. As discipline for her conduct, Dr. Riehl agrees to the following terms and conditions:

Dr. Riehl shall maintain and comply with all requirements of her June 2017 Lifetime Agreement with the APHP. Within seven (7) days of initiating any medical practice in the State of Maine or of any medical practice based upon her Maine medical license, Dr. Riehl shall enroll in the Maine Professionals Health Program ("MPHP") and ensure that there is coordinated monitoring between APHP and MPHP. Such coordinated monitoring shall include immediate notification of any violation of the June 2017 Lifetime Agreement or any MPHP monitoring contract, and of any positive or problematic toxicology test. Dr. Riehl expressly authorizes and agrees to execute any release necessary for the Board, Board staff, and the Board's assigned Assistant Attorney General to communicate directly with and obtain information from MPHP and/or APHP. Dr. Riehl shall ensure that the Board receives quarterly compliance reports from MPHP or APHP.

7. Dr. Riehl acknowledges that while this Consent Agreement is in effect she must directly communicate with the Board or Board staff and has the obligation to respond to any request for information or documentation within the timeframe specified or requested. Failure to comply with or respond to any request shall be considered unprofessional conduct and a violation of this Consent Agreement.

8. Any conduct of Dr. Riehl described herein may be considered in future Board action(s) as evidence of a pattern of misconduct.

9. The Board shall issue Dr. Riehl's license, contingent upon her meeting all other licensure requirements, upon Dr. Riehl signing this Consent Agreement and delivering it to the Board.

10. Violation of any of the terms or conditions of this Consent Agreement by Dr. Riehl shall constitute unprofessional conduct and grounds for additional discipline of her Maine medical license by the Board, including but not limited to imposition of civil penalties, or modification, suspension, and revocation of licensure.

11. This Consent Agreement is not appealable, constitutes disciplinary action, is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank, the Federation of State Medical Boards, and other licensing jurisdictions, and is effective until modified or rescinded in writing by all of the parties hereto.

12. The Board and the Department of Attorney General may communicate and cooperate regarding any matter related to this Consent Agreement.

13. This Consent Agreement is a public record within the meaning of 1 M.R.S. § 402 and will be available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 M.R.S. § 408-A.

14. Nothing in this Consent Agreement shall be construed to affect any right or interest of any person not a party hereto.

15. Dr. Riehl acknowledges by her signature hereto that she has read this Consent Agreement, that she has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Consent Agreement, that she executed this

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Consent Agreement of her own free will and that she agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.

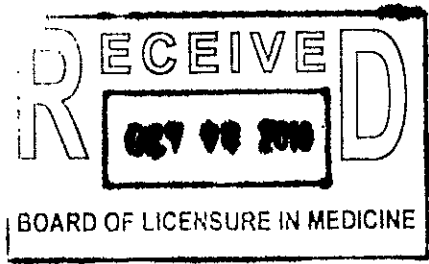
16. For the purposes of this Consent Agreement, the term "execution" means the date on which the final signature is affixed to this Consent Agreement.
