<b>Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC)</b>	Expired week ending December 26, 2020  Maximum 13 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>11 additional weeks</b> of benefits, to a maximum of 24 weeks.</li> <li>• PEUC is available until week ending March 13, 2021, with allowance of four additional weeks of benefits for those who have not reached the maximum number of weeks through week ending April 10, 2021.</li> </ul>
<b>Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC)</b>	Expired week ending July 25, 2020  \$600/week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 11 weeks of an additional <b>\$300 weekly</b> benefit to eligible claimants.</li> <li>• A claimant must be eligible through a separate unemployment program to receive FPUC.</li> <li>• Covers weeks of unemployment between Dec. 27, 2020 and week ending March 13, 2021.</li> </ul>
<b>Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA)</b>	Expired week ending December 26, 2020  Maximum 39 Weeks  Reduced by weeks of UI and EB.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>11 additional weeks</b> of benefits, to a maximum of 50 weeks.</li> <li>• Weekly certification required.</li> <li>• Claimants will be required to provide documentation of eligibility</li> <li>• PUA will be available until week ending March 13, 2021 (no new applications), with allowance for four additional weeks of benefits for those who have not reached the maximum number of weeks through week ending April 10, 2021.</li> </ul>
