Step-by-Step Instructions




Recent updates to the Continued Assistance Act now require claimants who have applied for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) to verify their identity.


This new requirement is part of ongoing efforts to detect and prevent fraudulent unemployment claims.

Step 1: Login to ReEmployME.


Enter <u>www.maine.gov/reemployme</u> into your web browser



Step 2: Select PUA Identity Documents then Upload PUA Identity Documents



Step 2: Enter SSN twice then select "Next".



Step 3: Select Photo IDs from dropdown, then select "Browse".


PUA Identity Document Upload * Required Information

Upload Documents for PUA Identity Verification

Provide two forms of Identification (scan or photos), one of which must be a government issued photo ID.


This could include Portable Document Format, Adobe documents (pdf), Word documents (doc, docx), and image files (gif, jpg, jpeg, png, or bmp).

Upload document can be of maximum 10 MB in size.






Step 4: Select "Next" once the Photo IDs appear below the Browse buttons.



Step 5: Select "Submit."



Step 6: A confirmation screen will appear.
