Seth Towle appeals from a decision of a Workers' Compensation

Board hearing officer (Elwin, HO) determining that the calculation of his partial

incapacity benefit includes his pre-injury fringe benefits as part of the pre-injury

average weekly wage, pursuant to the plain language of 39-A M.R.S.A. § 102

(4)(H) (Supp. 2012) and Coulombe v. Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Me., Inc.,

2002 ME 163, ¶ 11, 809 A.2d 613. He contends that because there were no post-

injury fringe benefits to add to the imputed post-injury earning capacity, it was

improper for the hearing officer to have added actual pre-injury fringe benefits to

the pre-injury average weekly wage. Rather, Mr. Towle argues that the pre-injury

fringe benefits should have been added *post hoc* to the partial compensation rate

initially calculated without reference to fringe benefits. We disagree.

[¶2] The hearing officer's interpretation and application of section 102 (4)(H) to the facts in this case were correct and consistent with *Coulombe*. The hearing officer neither misconceived the law nor applied the law in an arbitrary manner. *See Gushee v. Point Sebago*, Me. W.C.B. No. 13-1, ¶ 6 (App. Div. 2013).

The entry is:

The hearing officer's decision is affirmed.

Any party in interest may request an appeal to the Maine Law Court by filing a copy of this decision with the clerk of the Law Court within twenty days of receipt of this decision and by filing a petition seeking appellate review within twenty days thereafter. 39-A M.R.S.A. § 322 (Supp. 2012).
