[¶1] Robert Charest appealed a June 15, 2020, decision of the Workers' Compensation Board Appellate Division, *Charest v. Hydraulic Hose* 

& Assemblies, LLC, Me. W.C.B. No. 20-10 (App. Div. 2020), to the Maine Supreme Judicial Court, sitting as the Law Court. The Law Court issued its decision on March 30, 2021, with the following mandate:

Decision of the Workers' Compensation Appellate Division vacated. Remanded to the Appellate Division with instructions to vacate the decision of the administrative law judge and remand for further proceedings on the petition for review of incapacity.

[¶2] Pursuant to the mandate, Appellate Division decision No. 20-10, and the decision of the administrative law judge (*Collier*, *ALJ*), are vacated. The case
